# North Sumatra Independent Smallholders Receive Replanting Funds

Government's commitment to improve Oil Palm Smallholder's prosperity

Jakarta, 27 November 2017 – Indonesian President Joko Widodo met with smallholders partnered with Asian Agri at a ceremony to hand over funds for replanting of their oil palms. Members of Smallholder Association (KUD) Anugerah Jaya Mandiri Sejahtera met the President; RI Darmin Nasution, Coordinating Minister of the Economy; RI Amran Sulaiman, Minister of Agriculture; and other government representatives at Serdang Begadai Regency in North Sumatra. The funds will be used by the smallholders to replant 157 hectares of oil palm, which have reached the end of their productive life, in Perlabian Village, Kampung Rakyat District, North Labuan Batu Regency.

Bernard A Riedo, Head of Sustainability and Stakeholder Relations at Asian Agri, who attended the ceremony, extend his appreciation to the government and Bank BRI for their support to KUD Anugerah Jaya Mandiri Sejahtera during the process.
